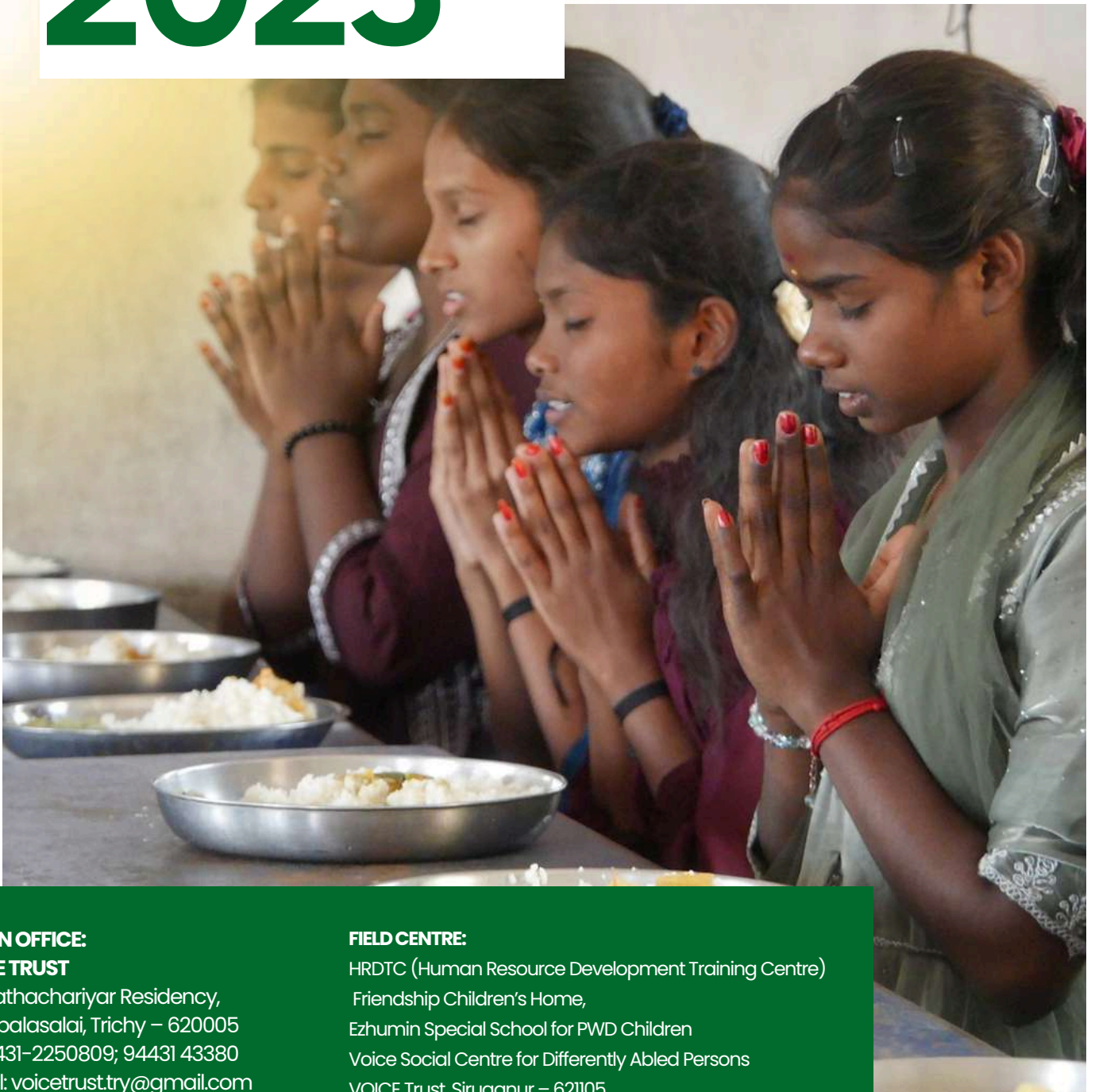

The Home operates with a strong belief that care does not end at childhood, extending support to alumni through higher education and career pathways.

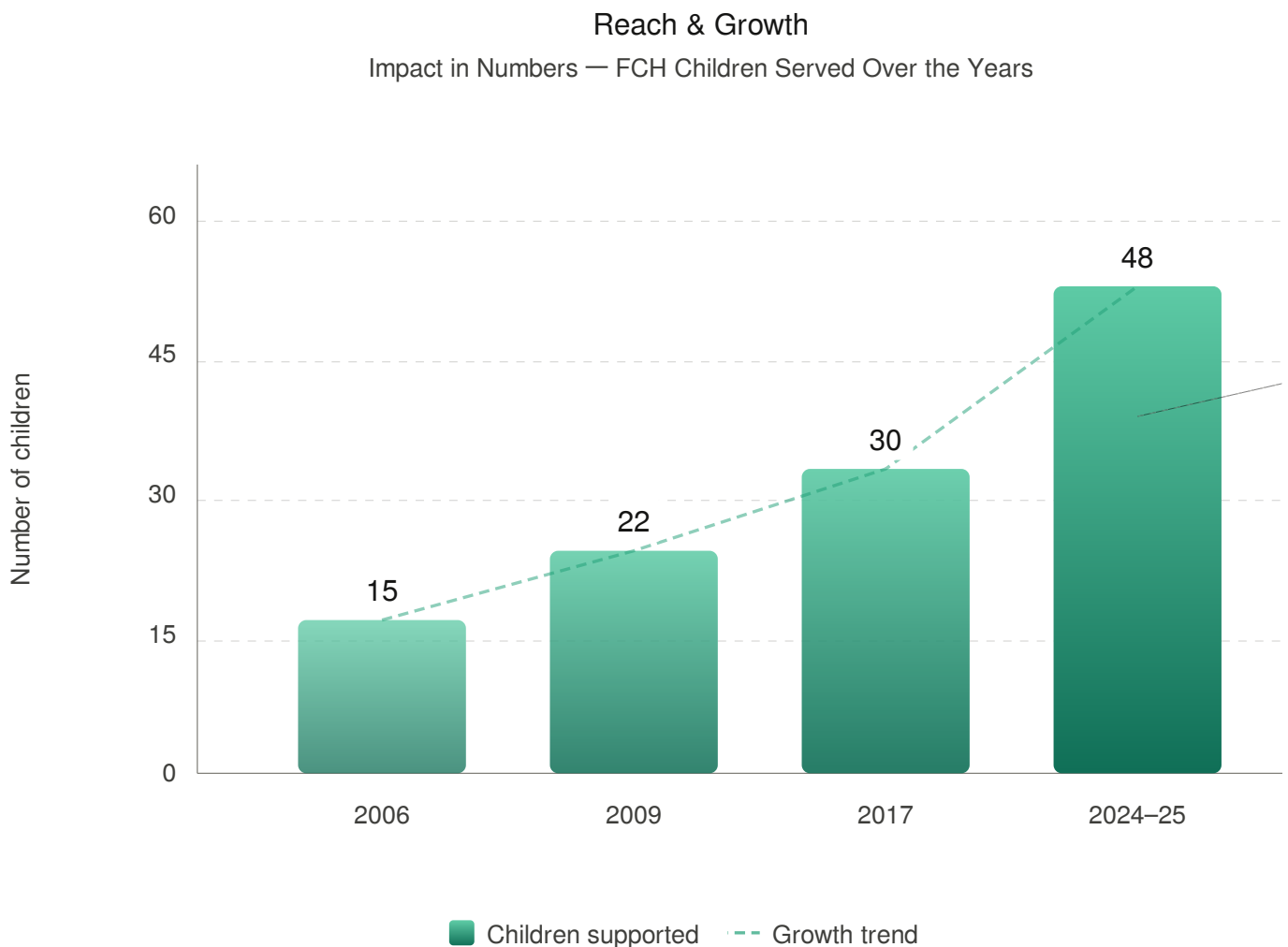


3. Residential Status and Continuity of Care



ORDER:

This license is awarded to “FRIENDSHIP CHILDREN’S HOME VOICE TRUST HOSTEL” is a hostel or lodging house or home for women and Children vide S.No. 1973/A1(83)/2022/Collectorate/Trichy district under section 5(2)/6(2)/7(1) of the Tamil Nadu Hostels and Homes for Women and Children (Regulation) Act, 2014. “MRS. JECINTHA AMIRTHAM” is the Director of the above said institution. The said institution is a hostel or lodging house or home for women or for children or for both women and children.

The license is valid for the period of three years commencing from 01.01.2025 to 31.12.2028. This license is meant for 40 numbers of inmates to be admitted by the institution. The institution shall comply with rules or regulations or instructions issued by the State Government from time to time regarding license. The license is granted subject to the following conditions namely.

1. The management shall run the institution in accordance with the Tamil Nadu Hostels and Homes for Women and Children (Regulation) Act, 2014.
2. This license shall be displayed prominently for the information of parents or general public in the office room.
3. The owner or the resident manager or the manager shall ensure average space norms of 40 sq.ft.per child and 120sq.ft. per woman.
4. Institution shall follow rules and regulations issued by State Government from time to time.
5. The institution is subject to inspection by the Inspection authorities under the Act. or Rules and by the persons or officers authorized by the State Government or district collector.
6. The infrastructure facilities shall be maintained properly.
7. The Institution Shall ensure proper education, child rights and necessary safeguards from child abuses.
8. The Institution shall ensure water and sanitation facility and also safe drinking water.
9. The Institution shall maintain sufficient supervisory and sub – staff as per the Act.
10. The Institution Shall maintain the kitchen in a hygienic manner.
11. The personnel of the institution shall be trained in handling fire safely facilities.
12. Rain water harvesting facilities shall be done in the institutions.
13. The Institution should not have any thatched structure or shall not construct any thatched structure in future.

If the hostel or lodging house or home for women and children is found to violate any one of the above said conditions, the license issued is liable for cancellation.



To ensure long-term impact, each child took ownership of nurturing the saplings by regularly watering and caring for them. This hands-on experience has helped instill a sense of responsibility, environmental consciousness, and commitment towards building a greener future.



Two-Day Educational & Recreational Exposure Tour to Munnar

A two-day exposure tour was organized for the children of Friendship Children's Home to Munnar, providing a blend of recreation, experiential learning, and group bonding. For many children, this was their first overnight trip, making the experience especially memorable and exciting.

During the visit, children explored key locations such as the Tea Museum, where they learned about tea production and grading, along with visits to the Botanical Garden, Pine Forest, Rose Garden, and Eco Point, gaining exposure to nature and environmental diversity.

To ensure inclusivity, a separate exposure visit to Pondicherry was arranged for children who were unable to travel to Munnar due to health concerns.

Overall, the tour offered a refreshing break, strengthened friendships, and contributed positively to the children's learning and emotional well-being.



One-Day Exposure Tour to Pondicherry (Inclusive Visit)

To ensure inclusiveness and equal opportunity, a one-day exposure tour to Pondicherry was organized for children who were unable to participate in the Munnar trip due to discomfort with hill travel.

The journey began early in the morning and concluded the same day, offering a safe and well-coordinated travel experience. During the visit, children explored key locations including a church, Auroville, and the beach, gaining a blend of spiritual, cultural, and recreational exposure.

The outing provided a refreshing break from routine, allowing children to relax, interact, and enjoy new surroundings. They actively participated in all activities and expressed great enthusiasm throughout the day.

Overall, the visit ensured that every child had the opportunity to experience travel, learning, and joy—supporting their emotional well-being and social development.



Difficulties faced and Solution found

i) The living rooms built in 2006 were meant for young babies. Now, that children are growing, the living space became congested

So, VOICE Trust converted 2 class rooms as living rooms for boys and maintained 1 class room as library. Dining place was used as additional study hall.

ii) The bath and Bathing facilities built in 1995 and in 2005 were not sufficient for the increasing number of children like 40 school going children in 2024-2025.

A new rest room complex was constructed in the eastern corner near river with 5 toilets and 5 bathing rooms and Boys use them. There are 4 toilets and 4 bathing rooms behind Friendship Children's Home and Girl children use them. Besides, there is 1 western toilet and 2 toilets / 2 bathing rooms attached to the hall near class rooms.

iii) Boys who stay in the 2 class rooms are afraid to go to the toilets near the river, especially at night. So, VOICE Trust has been asked to provide toilets near the class rooms for use by boys for night.

iv) There are emergency necessities for near living rooms for children with special facilities for girl children, new kitchen, new dining, new stores and living rooms for staff since women staff want privacy.

VOICE Trust will prepare applications for help from individuals and organisations. Appeal is placed before AEM Mission 2025 for guidance in this regard.

v) Salaries for many staff not included for the past 4 years. But, it is becoming difficult because VOICE Office has to spend from the donation amount.

VOICE Team will discuss with AEM Mission 2025 Team.

vi) Brilliance in studies are lacking among many FCH Children because all of them study in Government Schools.

Instead of 1 Tuition Teacher, we tried with 2 Teachers with supports from Mary Amma and Ponnar Suresh. But it is better to have 2 more Tuition Teachers.

vii) Some children learn wrong habits from school children and spoil the goodness of life in FCH.

VOICE Team is discussing with Head Master of School and they suggest 4 children to be discontinued. Because there are serious complaints.

viii) All FCH Children want Higher Education supports. For, individuals and NGOs who help now are deciding matters against their wishes.

VOICE Trust wants special supports from AEM from 2006.

ix) More electricity changes as number of children are more.
Total "Solar System" requested for FCH from AEM

x) Grown up Children wants VOICE Trust to spend for their marriage.
VOICE Team told them that it is the responsibility of relatives.

Discussions with Azim Premji Foundation the CSR arm of Wipro Company started from April 2025. Volunteers from Chennai especially People for Good met Officials in APF and presented many appeals on behalf of VOICE Trust for Friendship Children's Home. The question why only 42 children including 8 in higher studies when the Tahsildar has approved 100 children. VOICE team explained that buildings in 2006 were planned for 15 orphan children but the present number is 42 and it is very difficult to manage space and facilities for more number of children, Hence VOICE Trust appealed for new buildings and infrastructure developments. APF said that infrastructure developments like new buildings can wait since the priority will be quality services for children with sufficient staff to take care of all needs of children. So, the want of new buildings and infrastructure developments is great difficulty.

Finding well qualified and dedicated staff is another difficulty since many want to come in the morning and return home in evening. But, VOICE Trust explain that the staff should be living with children all the time so that they can extend valuable services for the needy children. Committed staff are still not available.

Being parentless and other disadvantaged children, VOICE Team has to guide them with good things in life. But, orphan children learn evil things including children from many villages having different background with difficult challenges for good life.

There is a growing tendency among relatives to opt for taking children to their homes because Govt. is providing special grants for orphan children. So, some children have to be removed from "JOY TO CHILDREN" Program.

Sometimes, the school management complaints that some children of FCH don't behave well and hence remain as optacles for good character for other children. VOICE Team gives special motivation for such children. If they correct themselves, than we continue in FCH. If not, we inform relatives to take them under their care

- Beneficiaries: 500 – 800 school children
- Key Components: Rainwater harvesting, solar energy, grey water treatment, climate curriculum, Bio intensive Garden, Eco Club, Climate Lab, mini micro forest and disaster preparedness training
- Outcome: Children become climate-aware leaders and schools become safer during extreme weather conditions.

3. Upscaling Ezhumini Special School (PWD Support)

Strengthening services for children with disabilities through therapy and mobility support.

- Beneficiaries: 40–60 Children with Disabilities (CwDs)
- Support Needed: Occupational therapy unit, assistive devices, and EV transport vehicle
- Outcome: Improved physical development, school attendance, and inclusion
- Many children currently face mobility barriers due to lack of transport.

4. Coastal Village Playground – Madavamedu (Mayiladuthurai District)

Creation of a safe and inclusive recreational space for marginalized coastal youth.

- Beneficiaries: 200+ children and youth
- Facilities: Kabaddi court, Volleyball ground, open gym/fitness equipment
- Outcome: Improved physical health, reduced risk behaviours, and community engagement
- The coastal village currently lacks structured play spaces for youth.

5. Emergency Medical Support – Infants & Children (Trichy District)

A rapid-response support system for critical child health needs.
